Though it is still cold most places in the states, we have just started our summer months here in Thailand. Schools have begun to close and most should be finished by the end of the week for the two month summer break. Our church will take advantage of the school break for many ministry opportunities. This month we will have VBS at church, a children's English camp down in Bang Saen, and a youth camp up in Chiang Rai. We will be teaching in VBS and at English camp. I will then fly up to Chiang Rai and preach one day of the youth camp. There is a lot going on this month, so please pray as we have many opportunities to share the gospel with our students.

I would like to thank everyone who prayed for my language assessment test back in November. I am thrilled to report that I passed the test and my missionary visa is secure and I will not ever have to take the test again! After over two years of rigorous language study, it was such an encouragement! Along the same lines of language study, two Wednesdays ago I gave my first message in Thai without the aid of a translator. Wednesday nights are a good time for me to get some practice as the message is a little shorter and there are less people. This month I will attempt my first Sunday message completely on my own. I am so thankful for the Thai Christians who give me kind instruction and encouragement! Language study has been a lesson in humility for both Heather and I, but the Lord is so good to enable us as we study!

Family update: Addisyn is two and a half going on about sixteen. She never wants to leave home without her purse and high heels. She loves going to church and all her Thai friends. Recently while playing with her dolls, Addisyn told Heather that her Barbie was going to church! Branson is seven months old and is still getting lots of attention for his big size and blue eyes. He is learning to crawl so he can keep up with his very active big sister. Heather is at home with them most of the week, but has continued with language study one day a week. We are very thankful to have found a Christian babysitter for the kids while we are studying. Addisyn having more of an opportunity to hear Thai is also an added blessing.

Please keep us in your prayers especially over the next month as we have many outreach opportunities. Our prayer is always that God will use the English as a tool to draw the lost in so we can give them the hope found only in Jesus Christ. Thank you for your faithfulness in prayers and support!
